In my time as a firefighter, I have seen numerous firefighters who share Kevin's level of calmness, competence, and bravery in quickly putting out a fire and caring for injured citizens. I am confident that Kevin would make an outstanding addition to XYZ Fire Department.

Kevin was awarded an industrial award for his bravery and skill after American Airlines Flight 77 crashed onto Interstate 65 in January. The Volunteer Fire Department was contacted first, and they were able to secure the crash site. Upon arrival, Kevin found fuel leaking from the tank of the burning plane. He saw the pilot unconscious still strapped in his seat. Kevin released the pilot and forcibly boarded his plane, cutting the pilot's safety belts and removing him from the plane moments before an explosion engulfed the plane in flames. He stabilized the injured pilot for transport to the nearest medical facility to wait for emergency medical treatment. Kevin is an authorized EMT-P paramedic and has at least two years of practical experience administering emergency treatment to disaster victims. He passed the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) and is still sitting for the big test, which assesses Physical Ability.
